Queens World Film Festival

 The Queens World Film Festival is dedicated to providing a platform for filmmakers to present their work to a diverse audience, fostering a vibrant community that celebrates independent cinema. Through year-round programming and special events, QWFF champions the power of film to inspire, educate, and entertain.

Hellenic Film Society

The Hellenic Film Society USA is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization rooted in the belief that Greek cinema can—and should—be part of the American cultural landscape. We promote feature films, documentaries, and film shorts made by Greek filmmakers and those of Greek descent, and films that promote the cultures of Greece and Cyprus.
